



# Laptop Protection Plan

Each year the Cape Elizabeth Schools offer an optional laptop protection program for parents as part of our MLTI (Maine Learning Technology Initiative) laptop program. As per our MacBook Take Home Guidelines:

"Replacement costs and/or repairs for damages that occur to the MacBook and its carrying case while it is signed out are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian. Replacement cost for an MacBook would be approximately \$1000. Damage to the screen (the most expensive part of the MacBook and one that is not covered by a warranty) can be over \$500."

This Laptop Protection Plan will protect your child's laptop from many items that are not covered by the manufacturer's warranty like:

- Accidental damage
- Liquid Spills
- Theft (Police report required)

Our Laptop Protection Plan will limit a family's financial responsibility to a \$100 deductible per incident, in the event of a claim. This plan is in effect for the duration of the 2009-10 school year and can be renewed each school year.
